

| Little Boy          | This atomic bomb<br>was made from<br>Uranium 235 and<br>was dropped on<br>Hiroshima□August<br>6,1945  | Robert Oppenheimer | Director of the<br>Manhattan Project<br>which built the<br>Atomic Bombs<br>used during World<br>War II.                     | Harry Truman                  | In 1947, this President gave Greece and then later Turkey money and aid to fight communist forces.                                      |
| Fatman              | This atomic bomb<br>was made with<br>Plutonium 239 and<br>exploded over<br>Nagasaki on August<br>9, 1945.                                   | Berlin Airlift     | The Allies responded to Stalin's blockade of Berlin by airlifting supplies into East Germany for 11 months.                 | George Marshall               | Truman's Sec. of<br>State who started<br>the program where<br>aid was given to<br>countries of Europe<br>after World War II.            |
