 <p><b>Warsaw Pact</b></p>	<p>This was Stalin's answer to NATO. If any nation were attacked the others would defend them or come to their aid.</p>	 <p><b>Trinity</b></p>	<p>This atomic bomb was tested July 16, 1945. Built at Los Alamos, New Mexico and exploded at Alamogordo, NM</p>	 <p><b>North Atlantic Treaty Org.</b></p>	<p>This organization started with ten member nations which promised to help each other in case of an attack from Russia.</p>
 <p><b>Tickling the Dragon</b></p>	<p>Bringing two metal hemispheres of highly reactive, beryllium-coated plutonium close together.</p>	 <p><b>Winston Churchill</b></p>	<p>Former Prime minister of Great Britain who gave the speech that an "iron curtain" had descended upon Europe.</p>	 <p><b>United Nations</b></p>	<p>Peace organization setup after World War II. First mentioned by Churchill and Roosevelt in the Atlantic Conference</p>
 <p><b>Germany</b></p>	<p>At the end of World War II, this country was divided into to four sections to keep it weak. It helped start the cold war.</p>	 <p><b>Franklin Roosevelt</b></p>	<p>President of U.S. who was part of the "Big Three" and attended the conference at Yalta. He gave it all to Russia.</p>	 <p><b>Dwight Eisenhower</b></p>	<p>Leader of the Allied Forces during World War II. Decided not to take Berlin and runs for president after the war.</p>
 <p><b>Little Boy</b></p>	<p>This atomic bomb was made from Uranium 235 and was dropped on Hiroshima August 6, 1945</p>	 <p><b>Robert Oppenheimer</b></p>	<p>Director of the Manhattan Project which built the Atomic Bombs used during World War II.</p>	 <p><b>Harry Truman</b></p>	<p>In 1947, this President gave Greece and then later Turkey money and aid to fight communist forces.</p>
 <p><b>Fatman</b></p>	<p>This atomic bomb was made with Plutonium 239 and exploded over Nagasaki on August 9, 1945.</p>	 <p><b>Berlin Airlift</b></p>	<p>The Allies responded to Stalin's blockade of Berlin by airlifting supplies into East Germany for 11 months.</p>	 <p><b>George Marshall</b></p>	<p>Truman's Sec. of State who started the program where aid was given to countries of Europe after World War II.</p>
